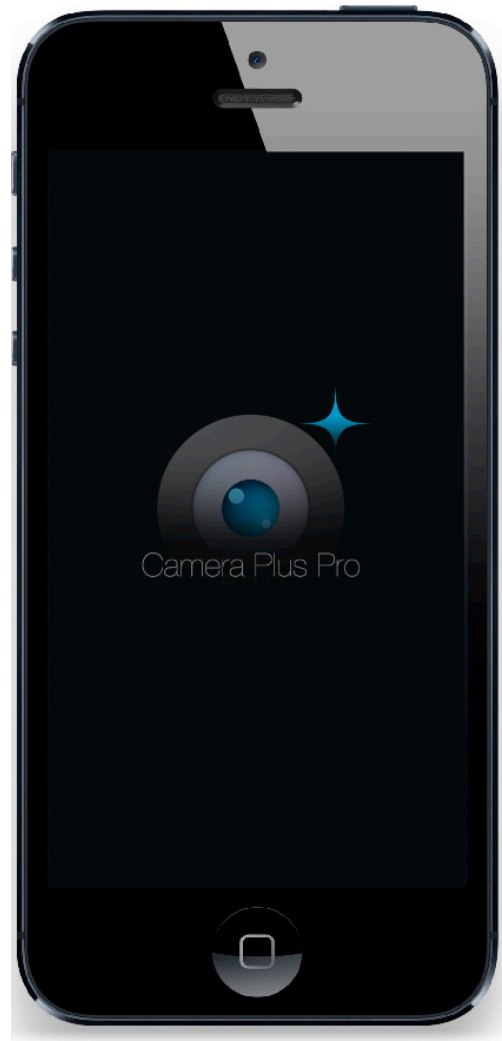

What's new in Camera Plus Pro 5.0:

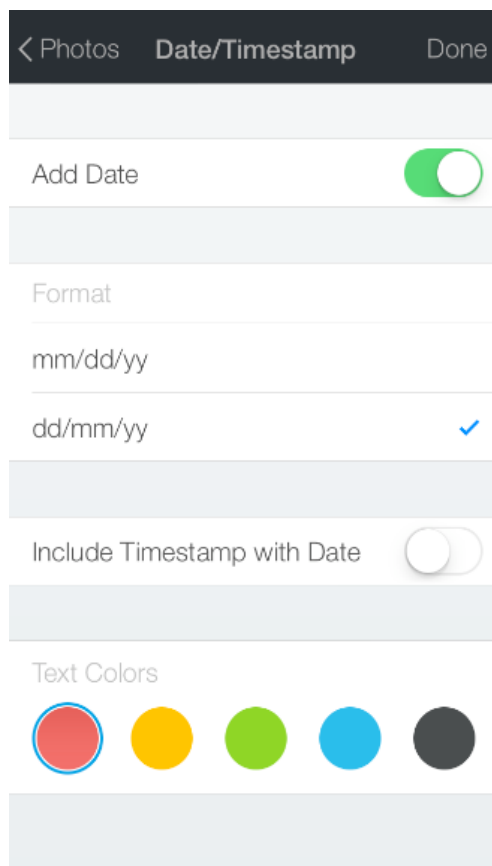
1. Brand New iOS 7 Themed User Interface and Graphics:

Camera Plus Pro is now in a refreshing new package that includes suave and subtle blacks, and allows you to access to your photos and videos easier than before.

Everything has been given a new lease of life, so hold that phone up and get down to some serious clickin'!

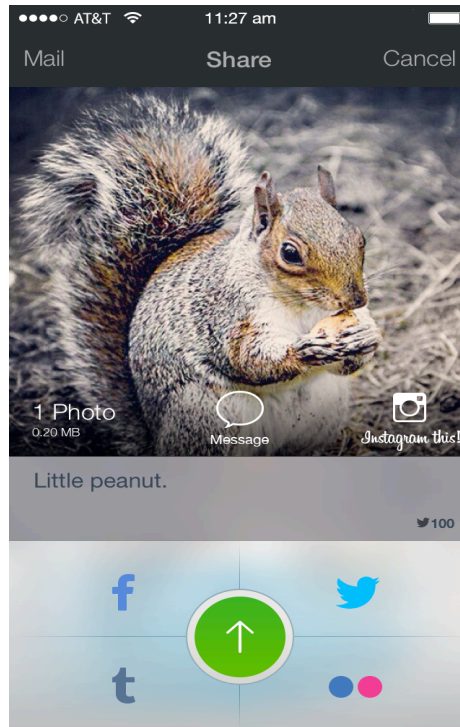
2. Timestamp Feature for Photos:

You now have the option to save the Time along with Date when capturing those precious moments.



3. Effortless iMessage Sharing:

Camera Plus Pro includes iMessage as an option for those of you who prefer sending your captures this way.



4. Open Photos using other compatible apps:

Camera Plus Pro v5.0 lets you open your photos in other compatible apps. The “Open in” option allows you to export photos into other apps.



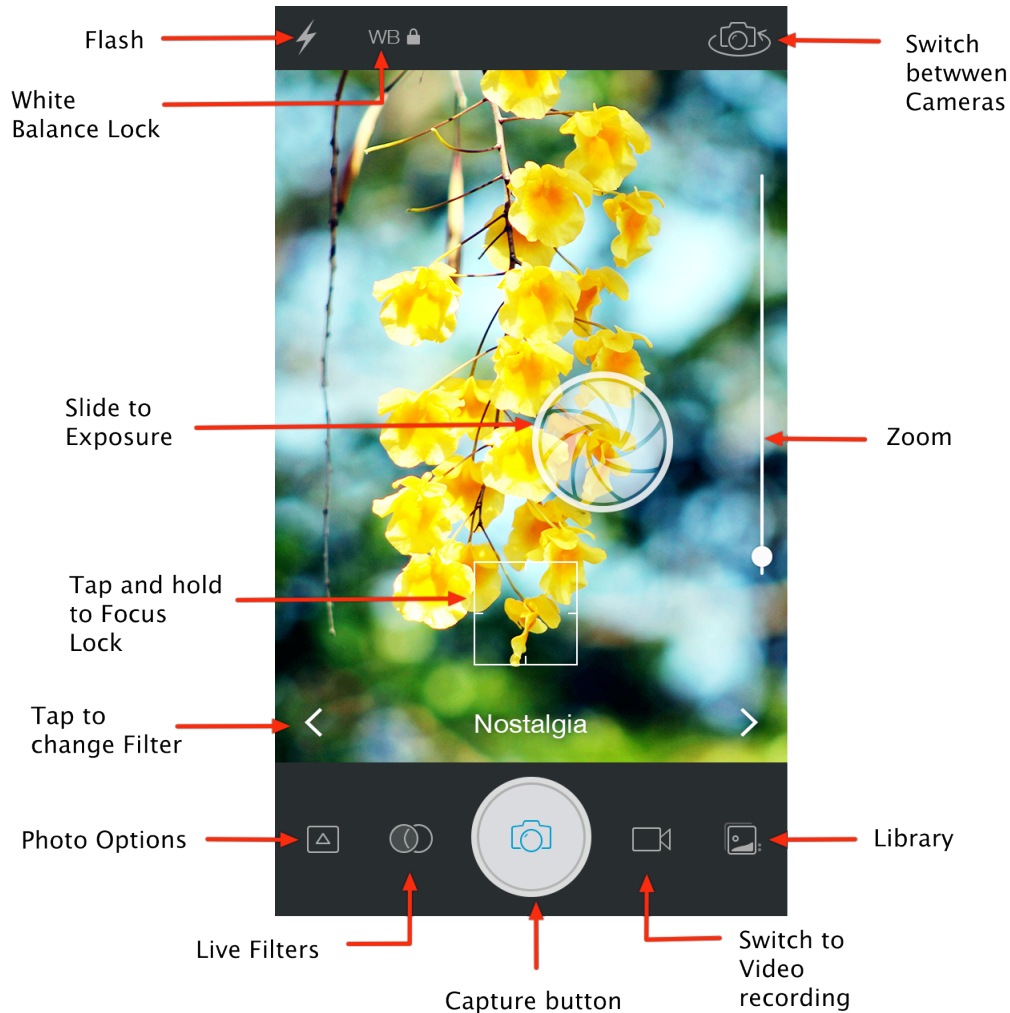
5. Video zoom in HD mode:

The new version can zoom in when recording a video in HD. Video Zoom in HD mode is supported on devices like iPhone 5, 5c, 5s and iPod 5th Gen.



Know your Camera Plus Pro UI¹:

Photo Capture Main Screen:



Flash: Tap to turn On/Off the LED Flash. (Only available on iPhone 4, 4s, 5 and iPod Touch 5G)

White Balance Lock: Tap to lock the *White Balance (WB)* to the current setting. Tap again to enter *Automatic White Balance (AWB)* mode.

Switch between Cameras: Shifts between the front and rear cameras.

Slide to Exposure: Slide on the screen to adjust the Exposure control for the photo.

All the images of Camera Plus Pro UI are as viewed on an iPhone 5 or iPod Touch 5G.

Tap to Focus: This onscreen ring shifts the focus onto the object you desire.

Long Tap to Lock Focus: Tap and hold your finger to lock the camera's focus on a particular area.

Zoomⁱ: Use the Slider to zoom up to 5x.

Photo Options: Tap to display the different *Photo Capture Options*, *Tags*, *Settings* and *Info*.

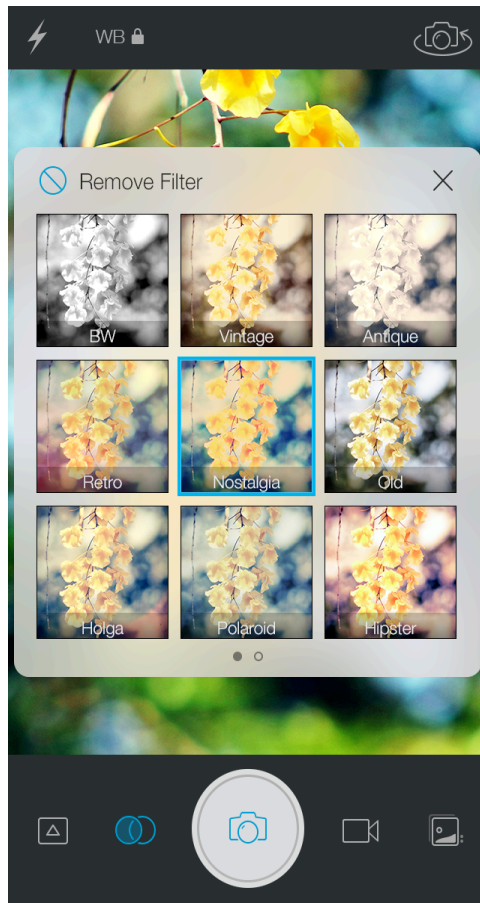
Live Filters²: Contains Live Filters when capturing photos.

Capture Button: Tap to capture a photo.

Video Recording: Switches to the video recording mode.

Quick Roll: The local Photo and Video Library that holds your captures.

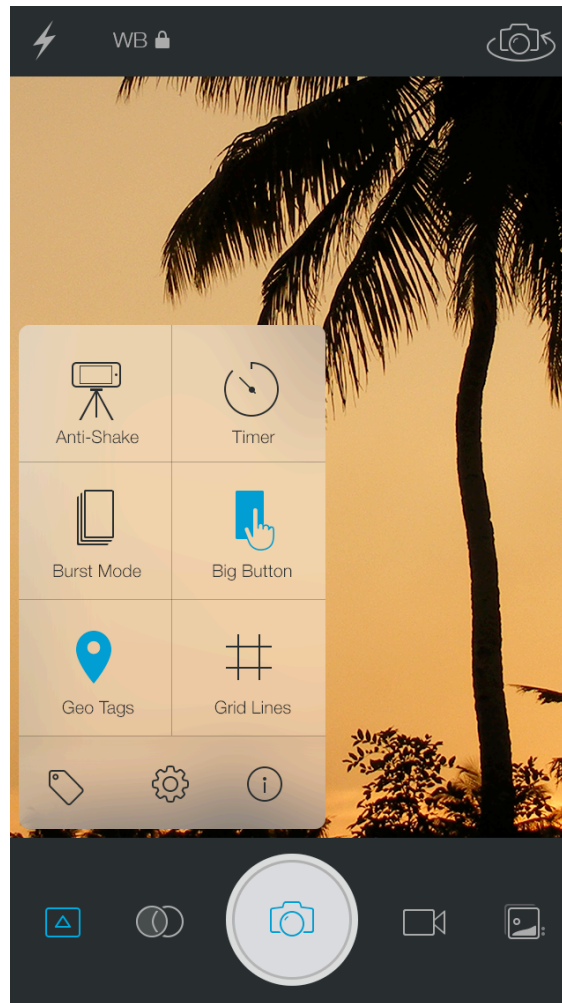

Note: Tap on *Remove Filter* to remove any selected Filter and go back to normal mode.

Photo Options:



Anti-Shake: Prevents your camera from taking pictures when it isn't steady.

Timer: Can allow for countdowns up to 10 seconds before capturing a photo.

Burst Mode²: Captures up to 10 photos in a single go.

Big Button³: Allows you to tap anywhere on the screen for a capture.

Geo-tags: Add Geo-tags to photos.

Gridlines: Applies gridlines for perfect photo alignment.

Tags: Add tags to photos for categorization. Also delete and manage tags.

² Live Filters is deactivated for faster photo capture in Burst Mode.

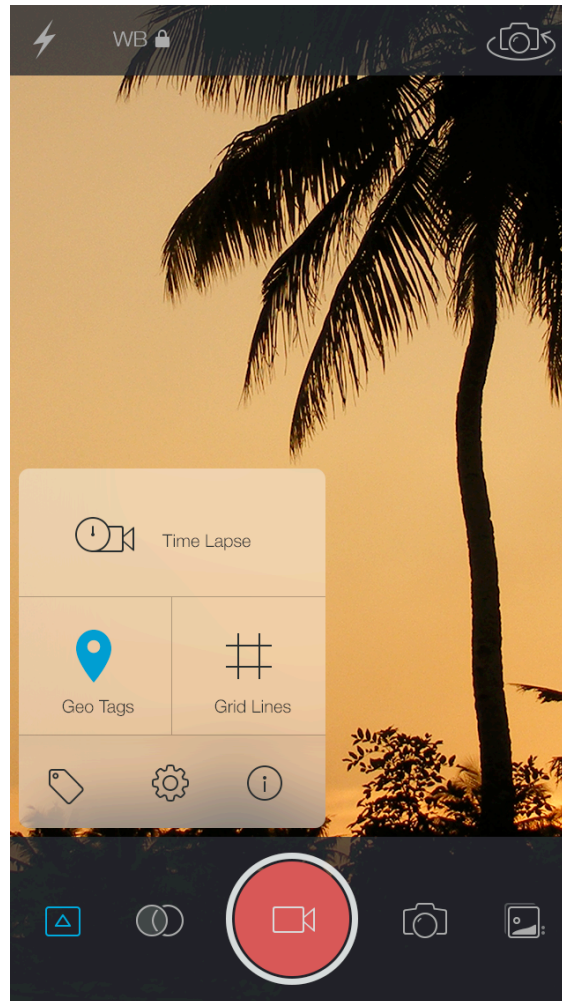
³ Slide to Exposure will now work in Big Button mode too. Tap to press and slide to adjust Exposure, release to capture photo.

Settings: Panel to manage Photo Settings.

Info: Contains information details of Camera Plus Pro and certain Tips & Tricks.

Note: *The Photo Capture button will change depending on the feature selected, i.e., Anti-Shake, Timer or Burst Mode.*

Video Recording Screen:



The various Video Options are as follows:

Time-Lapse^{*}: Create fast-motion movies with the Time-Lapse feature.

Geo-tags: Add Geo-tags to videos and edit/view Geo-tags.

Gridlines: Applies gridlines for optimal video alignment.

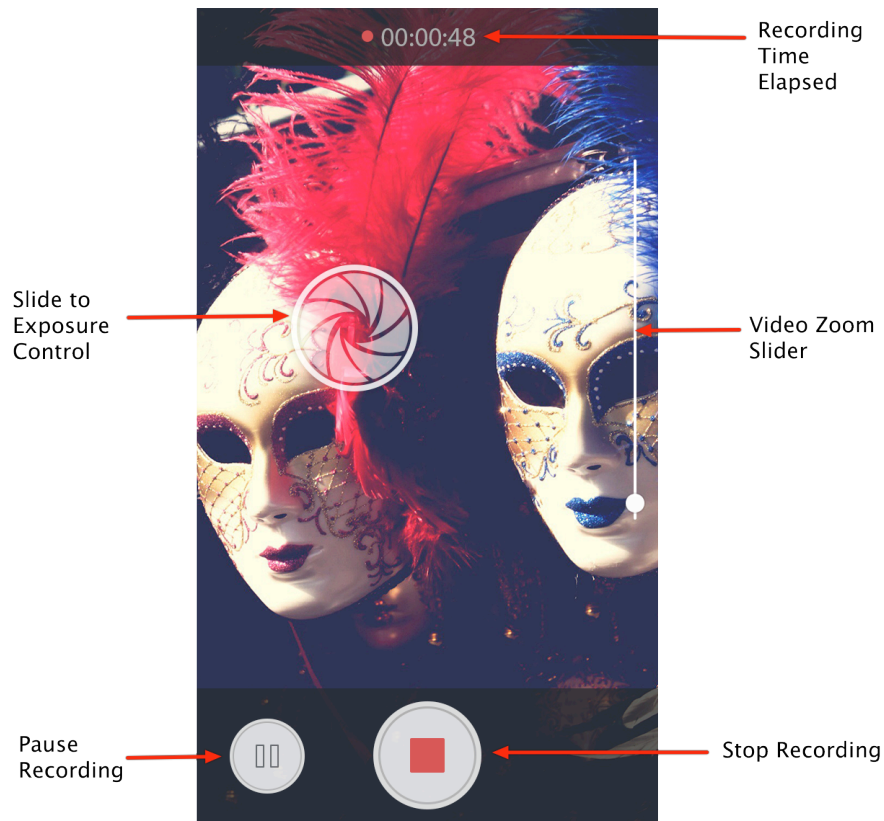
⁴ ^{*} **Note:** *During Time Lapse video recording, the Video Record Button changes to Time Lapse Recording Button. (Indicator)*

Tags: Adds tags to videos. Also delete and manage tags.

Settings: Manage Video Settings.

Info: Contains details of Camera Plus Pro and Quick Tips & Tricks.

Video recording in progress:

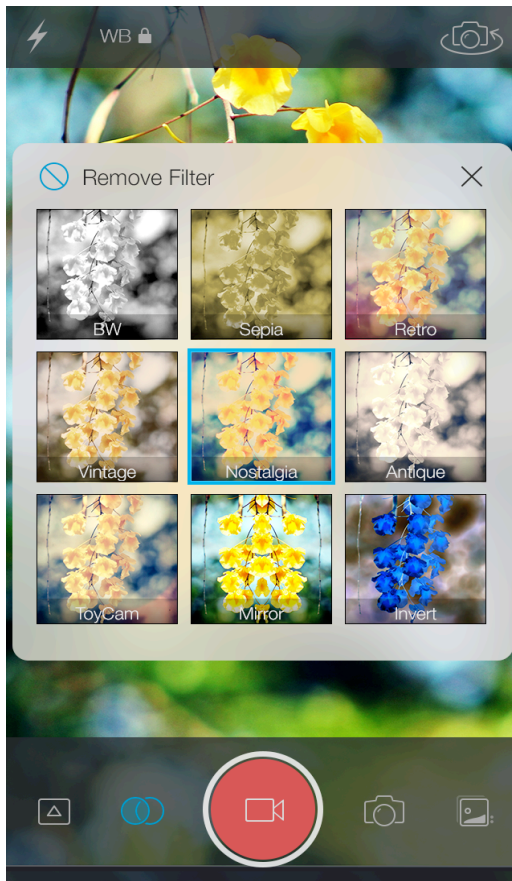


With Video Recording in Camera Plus Pro, you can:

- Pause during capture and continue recording; playback included
- Zoom* smoothly up to 5x in real time.

Live Video Filters:

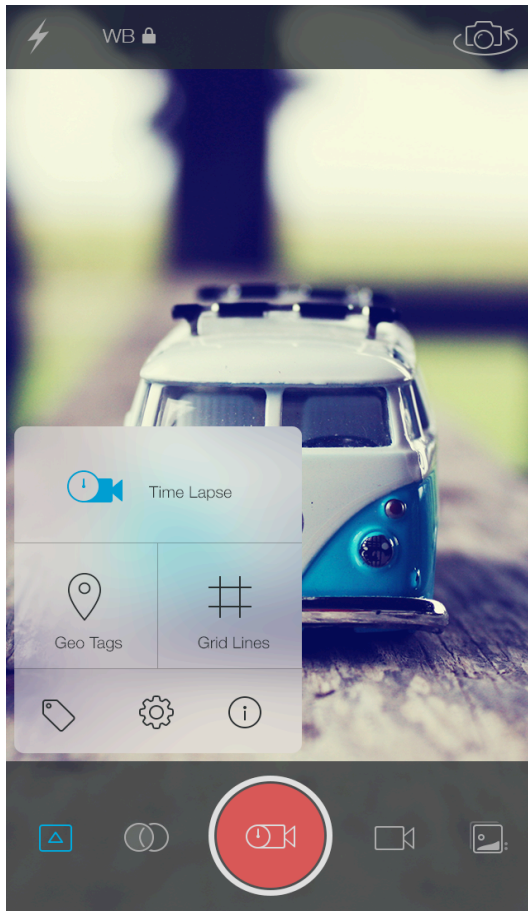
- You can choose from different Live Filters by selecting, by shifting through the left and right arrows at the bottom. The names of the filters are also present for easy identification.
- You can also choose Live Filters by tapping on the icon consisting of two circles on the Main Screen.



The 9 available Live Video Filters are:

- BW
- Sepia
- Retro
- Vintage
- Nostalgia
- Antique
- ToyCam
- Mirror
- Invert

Note: Tap on Remove Filter to capture photos in normal mode.



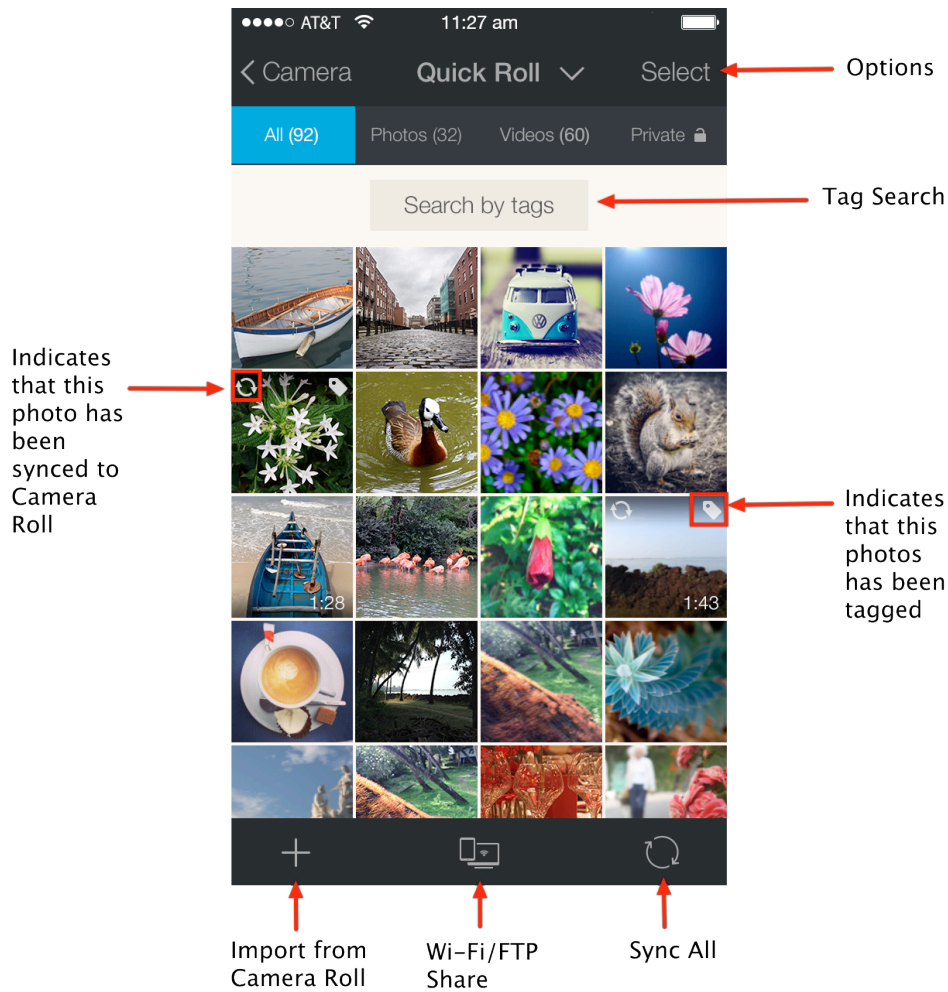
Time-Lapse Video⁵:

Time-Lapse videos are fast-motion movies that create a beautiful effect. During Time-Lapse recordings, the frames are recorded at a slower rate. Thus, when played back at a normal speed, the video appears to be moving faster, thus creating a ‘lapse’ effect.

Note: Sound is not recorded during a time-lapse video recording.

Quick Roll:



Options Screen: Find more sharing, locking, add/edit tags options here.

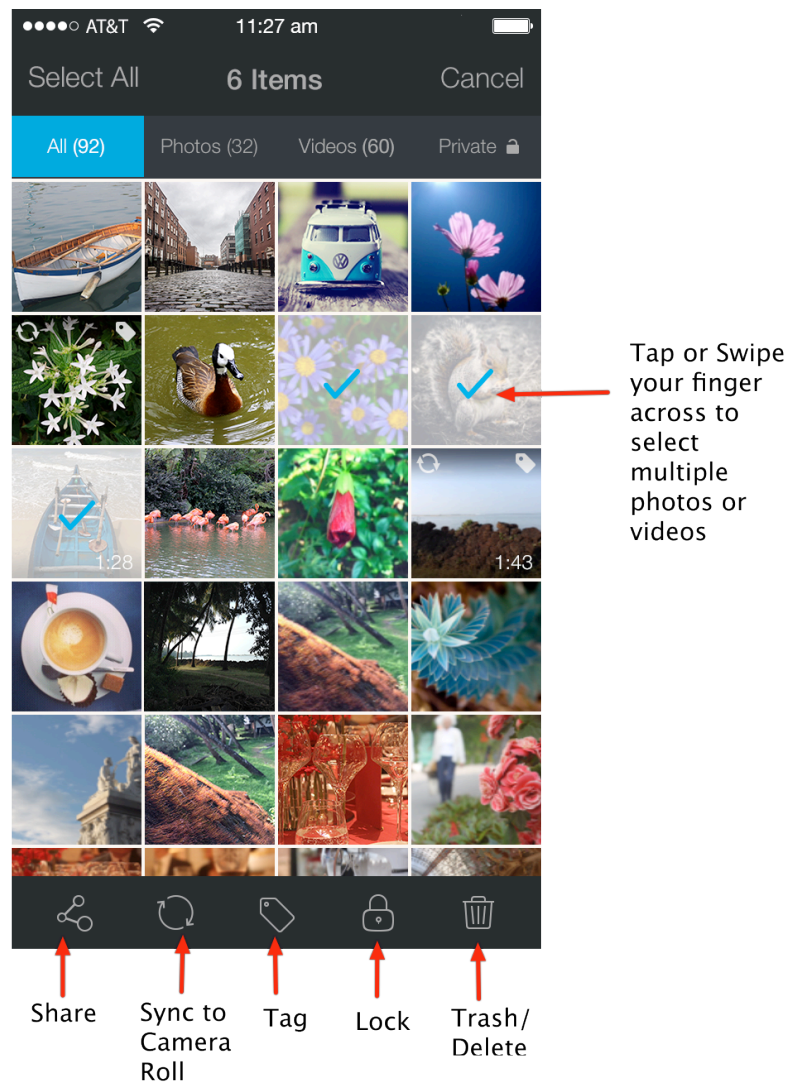
Tag Search: Search for photos/videos with the help of tags using this option. Slide a finger down the screen with a pull-down gesture to display this feature.

Import from Camera Roll: Lets you import photos/videos from your Camera Roll to Camera Plus Pro's Quick Roll where you can edit and share them.

FTP/Wi-Fi Share: Share your media with everyone via FTP or Wi-Fi; you can browse through photos and videos directly on your system using Wi-Fi.

Sync All: Selecting this option syncs all photos and videos to the Camera Roll with a separate copy maintained in the Quick Roll.

Options Screen:



Selecting the photos/videos enables the icons in the Toolbar.

Share: Lets you share the photos and videos that you have selected. You can share multiple photos at once.

Sync to Camera Roll: Lets you sync the selected photos and videos to the Camera Roll.

Tag: Lets you apply and create new tags for your photos/videos.

Lock: Lets you protect your private photos/videos.

Trash: Delete photos/videos.

Photo Editing Screen:



Aspect Ratio Crop: Remove portions of any image that you don't want along with 4 different cropping options according to aspect ratio.

Rotate: Rotate or flip photos and give them a more creative look.

Flash: Fix darker photos by applying upto three levels of Flash (this imitates the effect of a Flash) and preview them real time.

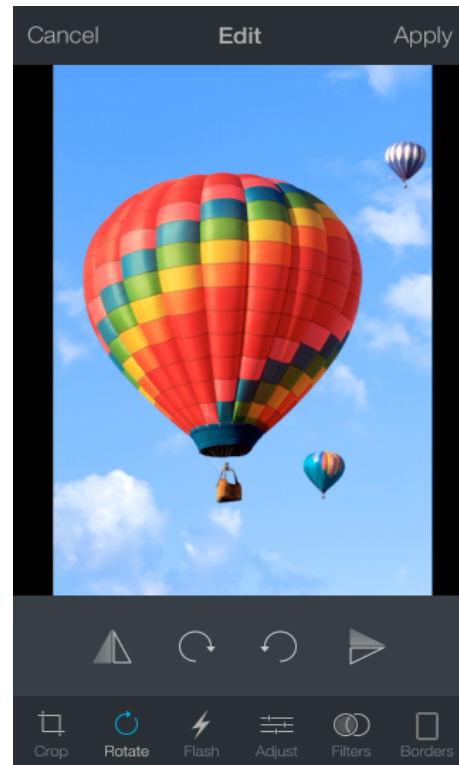
Adjust: Give your photos more emotion along with a warm/fuzzy/artsy look by adjusting the Hue, Saturation, Tint and more.

Effects: Choose from among 36 Photo Filters and 9 Distortion Effects such as Retro, 70s, Sunset, Fish Eye, Light Tunnel and more to make photos even more special.

Borders: Choose from 9 different borders such as Polaroid, Stamp, Torn, Thin White and more to add an elegant touch to photos.



CROP photos by adjusting the corners.



ROTATE photos and also flip it horizontally or vertically.

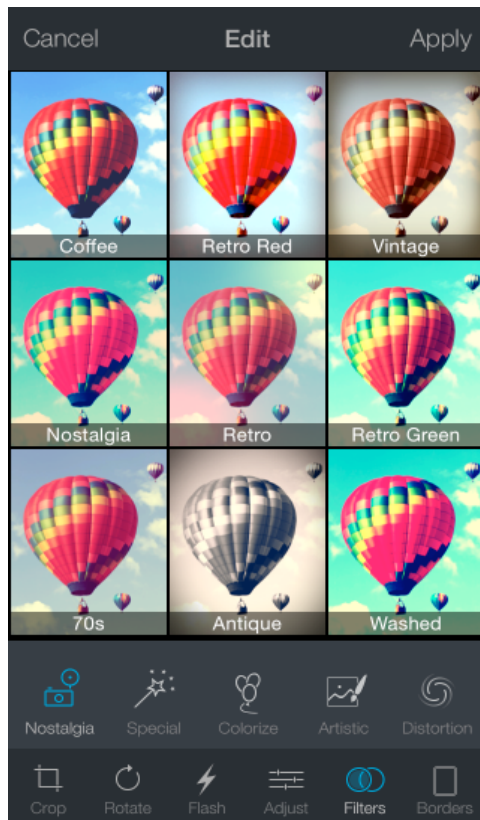


3 levels of **FLASH** for captured pics

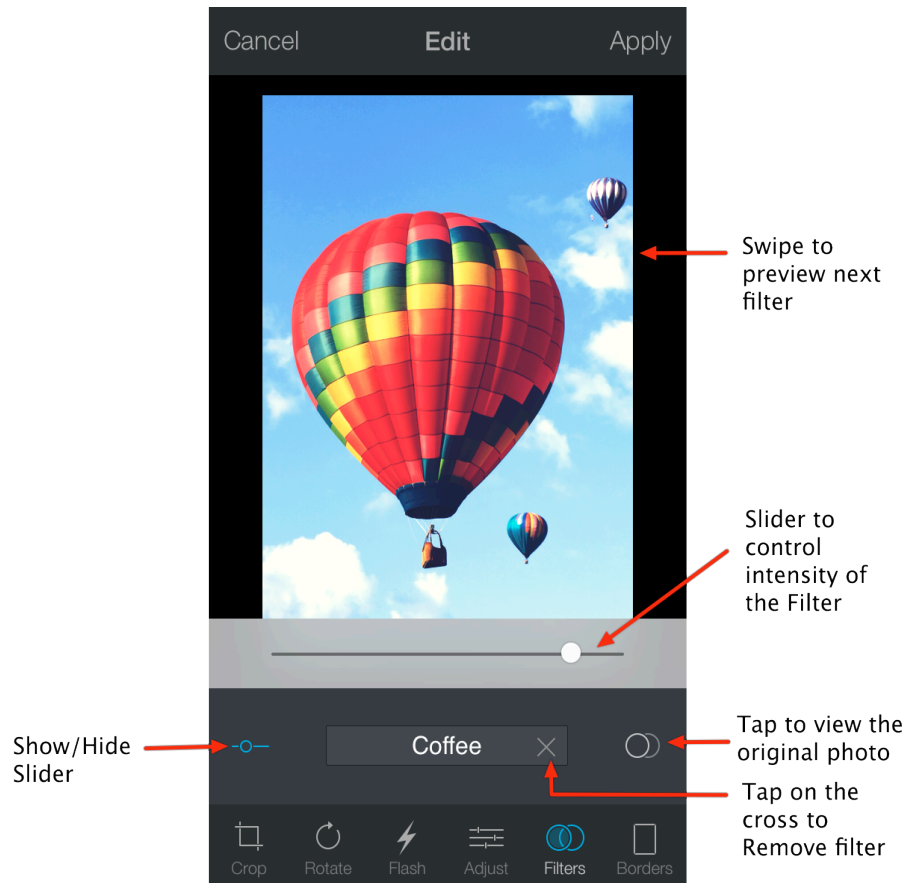
Photo Filters:



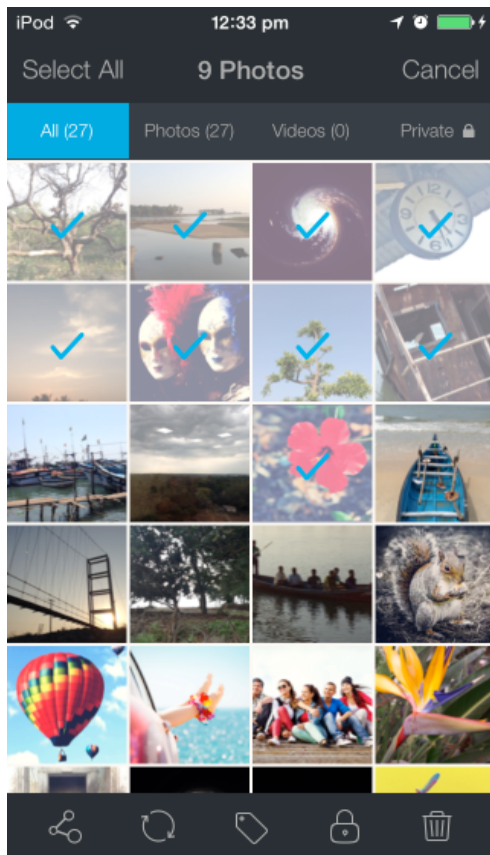
Apply 36 new and gorgeous Filters categorized under **Nostalgia**, **Special**, **Colorize** and **Artistic**.

Swipe left and right on the screen to preview different filters and their effects.

Tap on the filter to apply the effect.



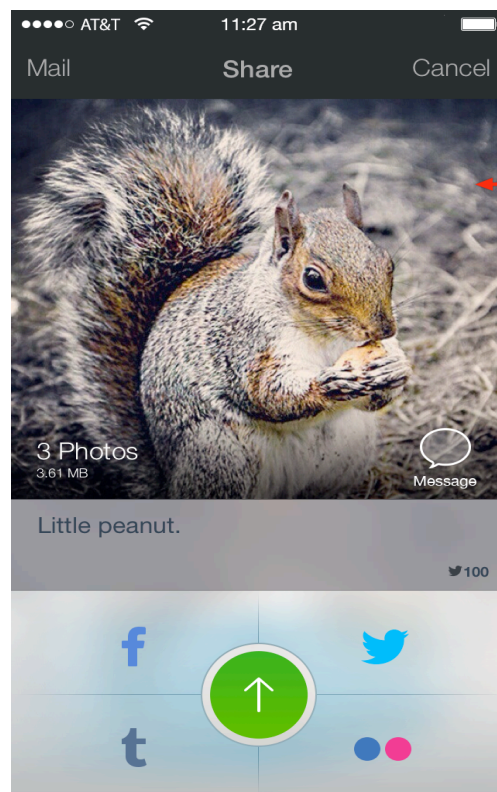
Share Screen:



In the Quick Roll, tap on **Select** and choose the photos you want to Share. Next, tap on the **Share** icon at the bottom.

With Camera Plus Pro, you can instantly share photos/videos to multiple sites at one go.

Select the desired service and enter any description text to Upload (arrow icon).



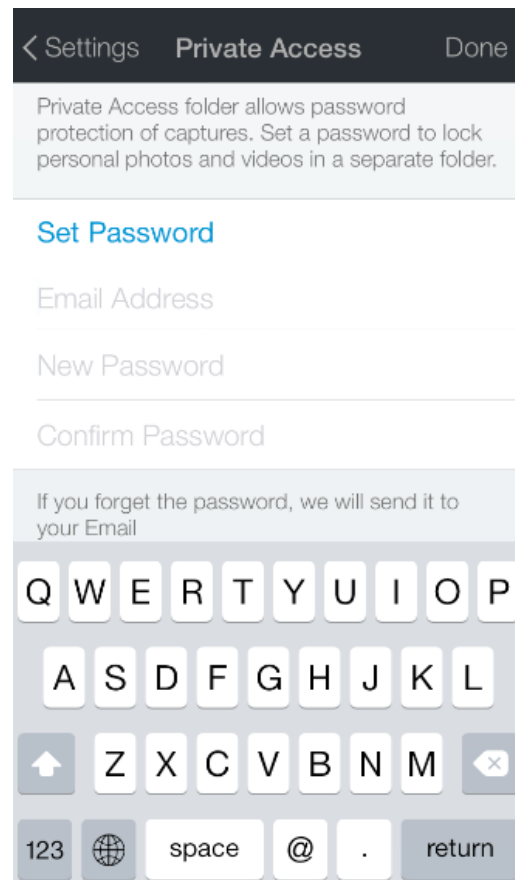
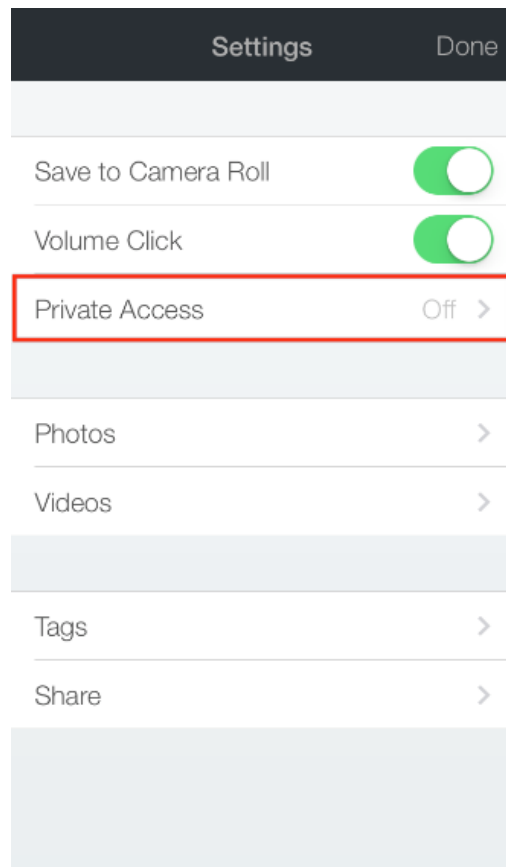
Tap on the photo to view all 3 selected photos to Share. You can also add Copyright text or Remove any photo.

Photos/Videos Privacy Settings:

Unless you've set a password, anyone can view your locked photos and videos in the Private folder. Go to Settings in order to set a password. Take note of the following as well:

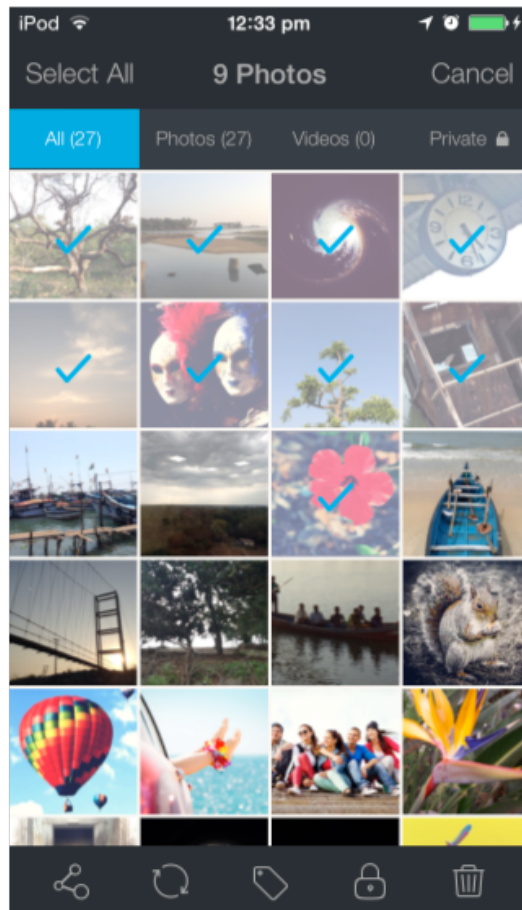
- Ensure that you remember the password.
- Locked photos/videos cannot be shared via the Wi-Fi/FTP option.

Camera Plus Pro can help retrieve the password in case you forget it. At the time of setting a new password, you can provide your email ID so that you can receive your code.



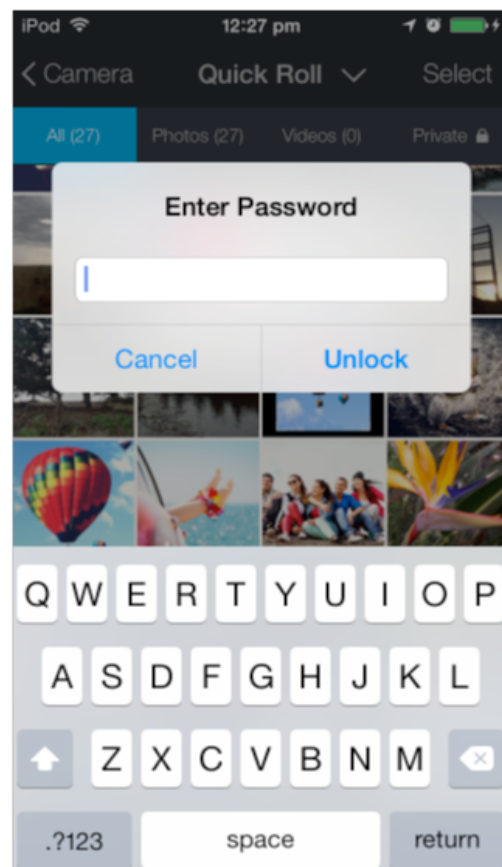
1. You can now set your password.

Note: *Do remember to note it down. Photos/videos, once locked, can only be retrieved with the set password.*

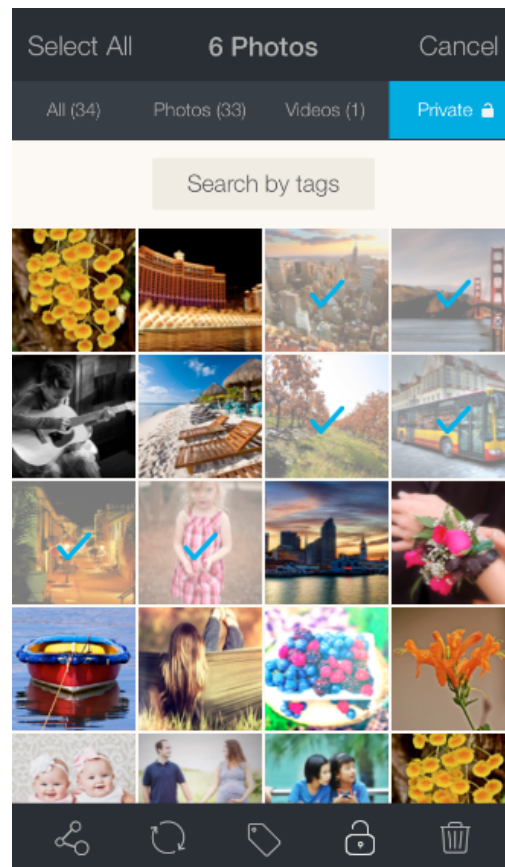


2. After tapping on **Select** and choosing your photos and videos, hit the **Lock** icon at the bottom. The selected captures will be moved into the **Private** folder.

3. On prompting for the password, enter it and then hit the **Unlock** button. You can now view the contents of your **Private** folder.



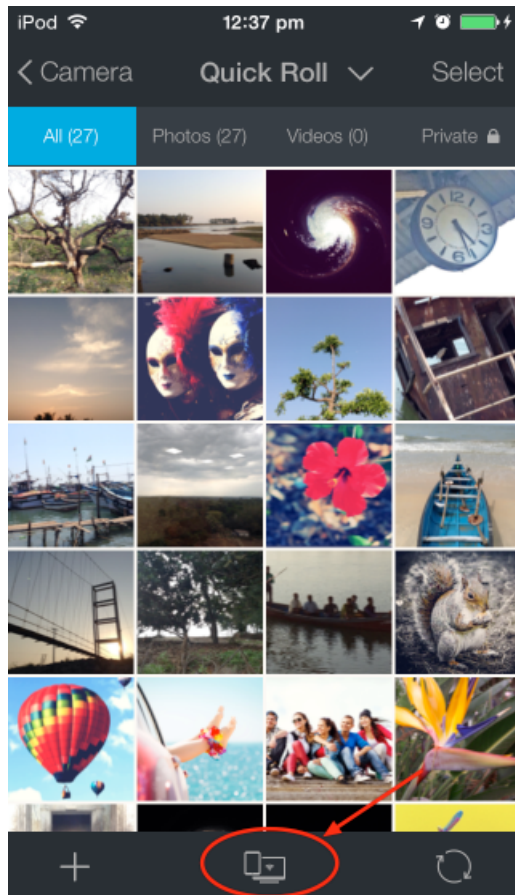
4. You now get to manage your Private captures; and Share, Sync, Tag, Unlock or Delete photos or videos in the Private folder. Unlocking a photo or video will move the selected photo/video back to the Library and can now be viewed by all.



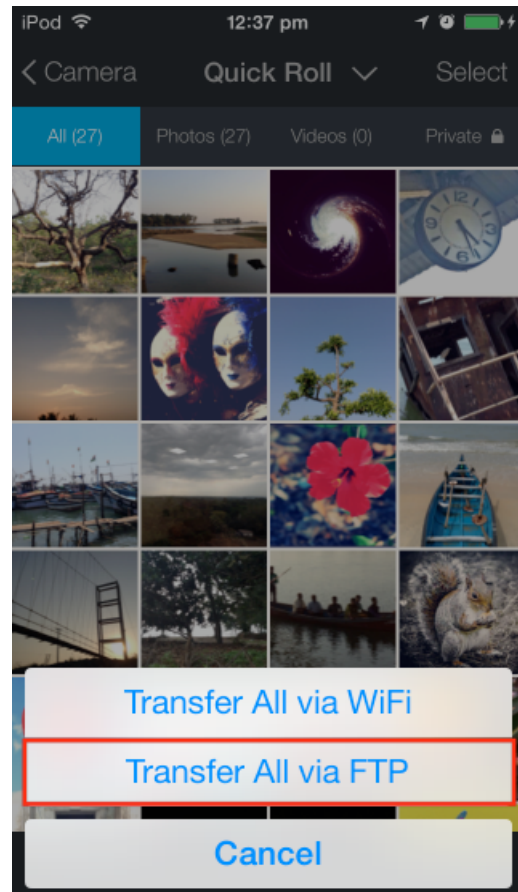
FTP/Wi-Fi Share:

You can easily transfer all your photos and videos to your PC, using the FTP/ Wi-Fi sharing option. To do so, you must connect both devices to the same network.

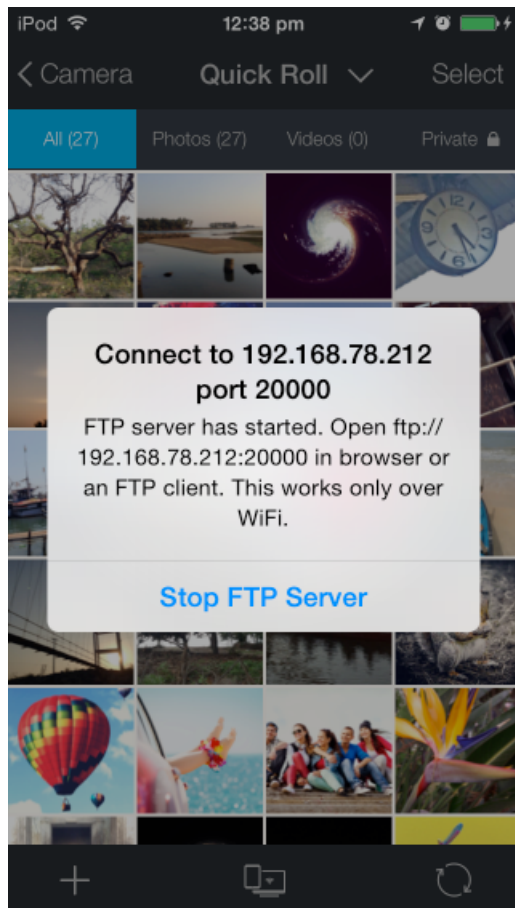
FTP Share:



1. Tap on the **FTP/Wi-Fi Share** button highlighted above.

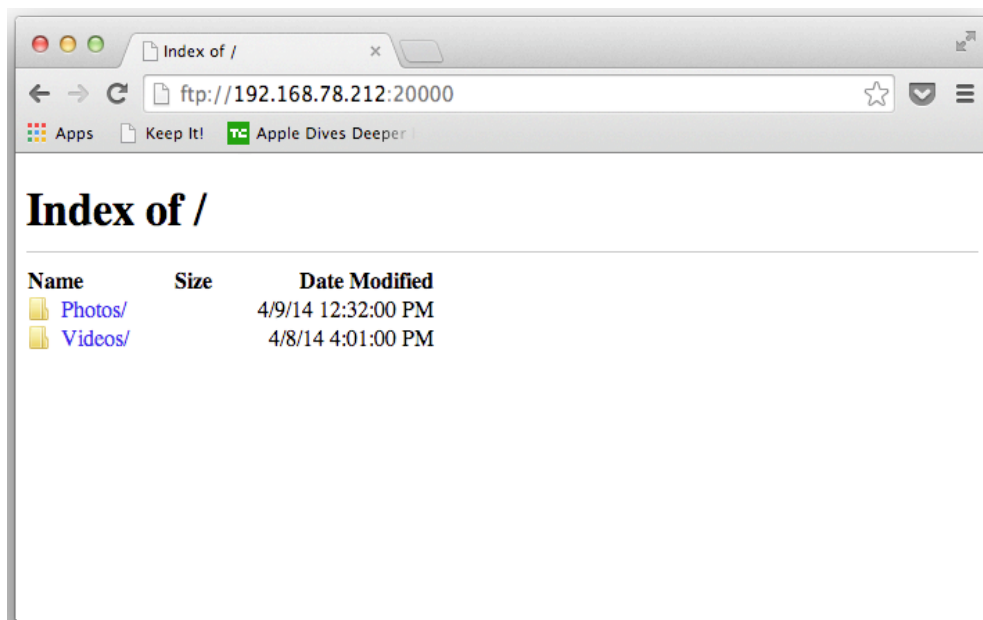


2. Set the **FTP Share** option.



3. Open the browser on your system and type in the address as given by the prompt that comes up.

4. This is how photos and videos will appear on your Mac's browser:

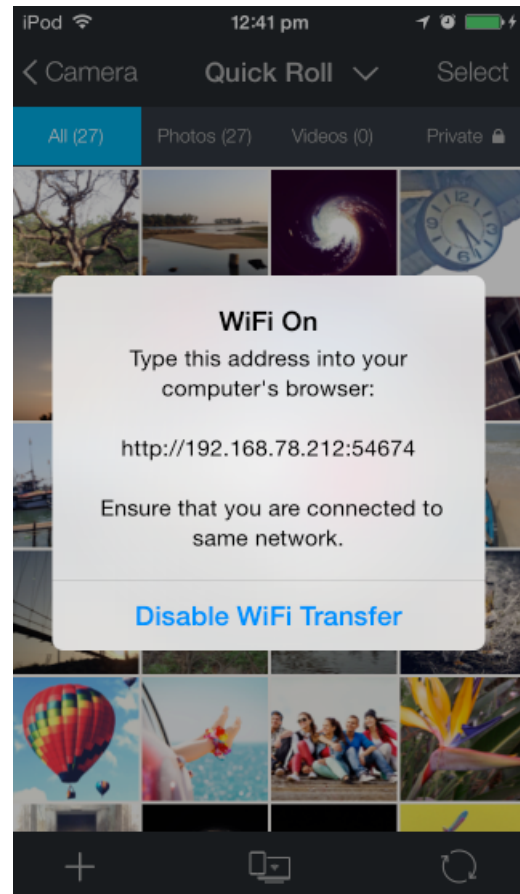


Notes:

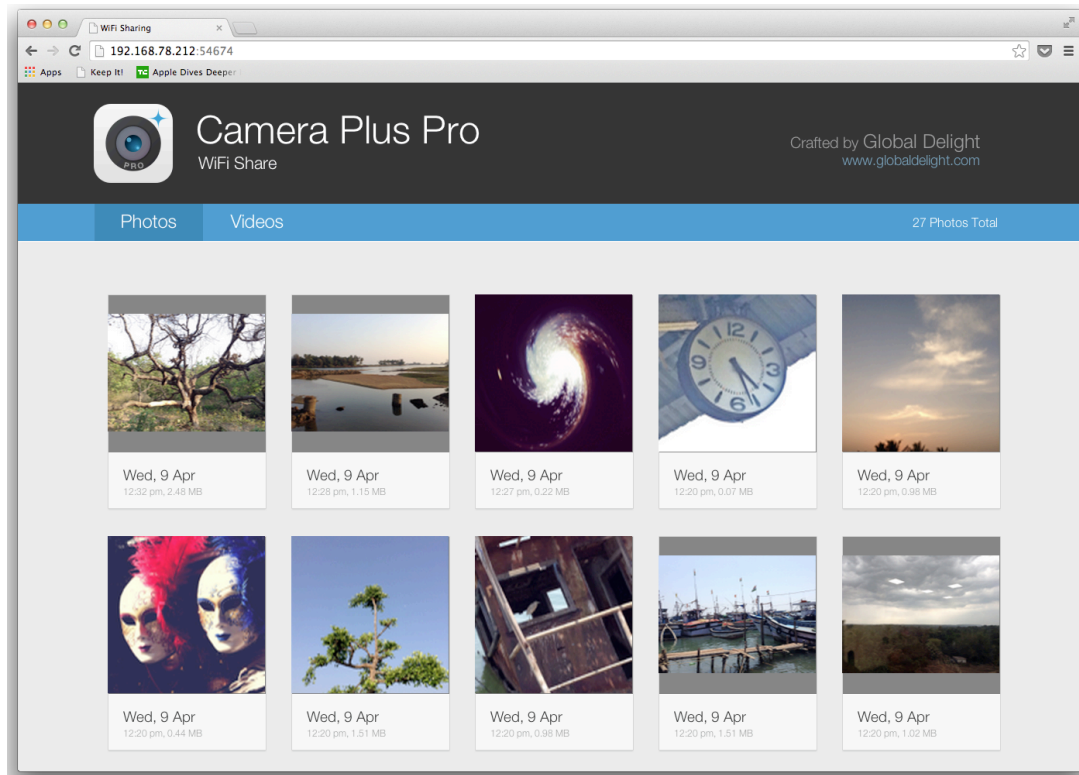
- For both Mac and Windows, third-party FTP Clients like FileZilla can be used for FTP transfer.
- In Windows, copy and paste the FTP address into Windows > Run or Windows Explorer to view the photos and videos.
- For Mac, open Finder and press 'Cmd+K'. Type in the entire FTP address to view photos/videos.

Wi-Fi Share:

1. Select the **Wi-Fi Share** option.



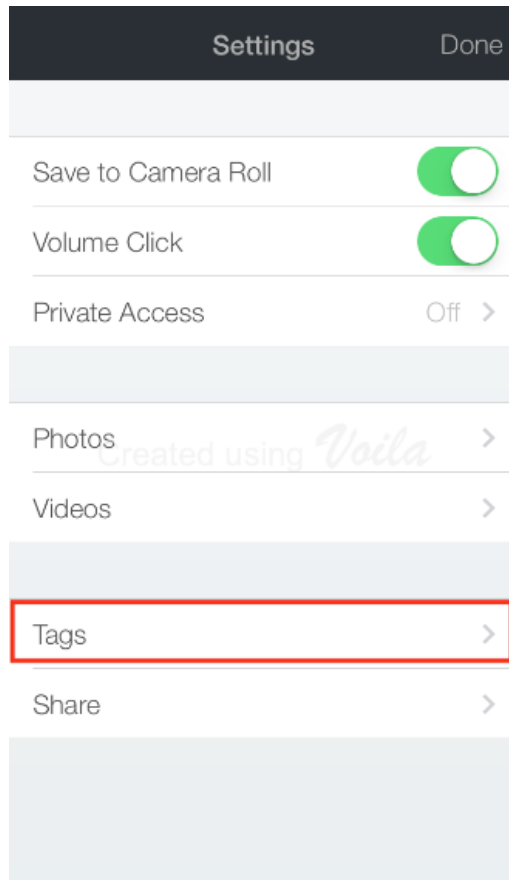
2. Open a browser on your system and type in the address that pops up when you select the **Wi-Fi** option.



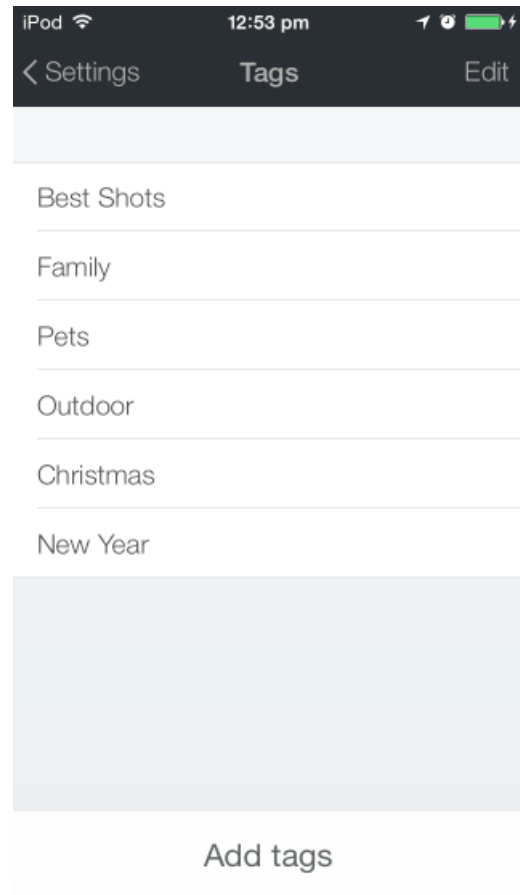
3. This is how photos and videos appear in browsers on Mac/Windows.

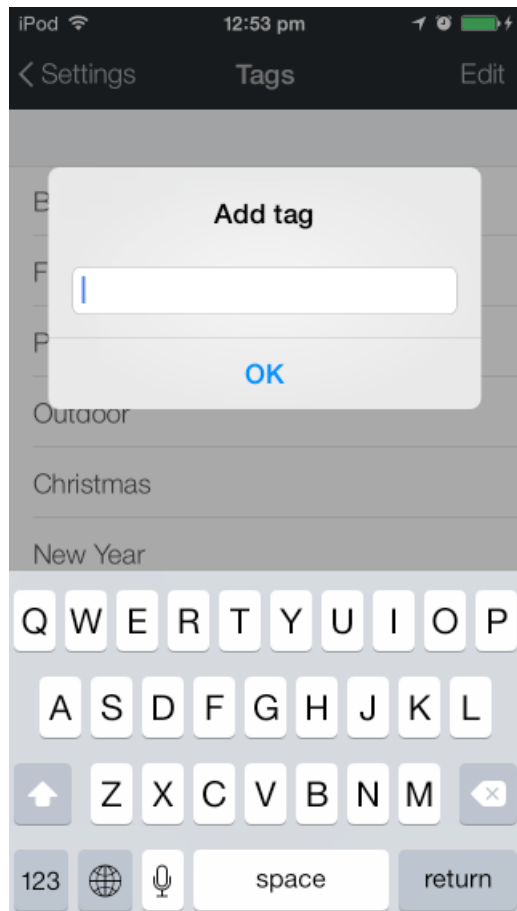
Managing Tags in Settings:



1. Go to **Settings** and select **Tags**.



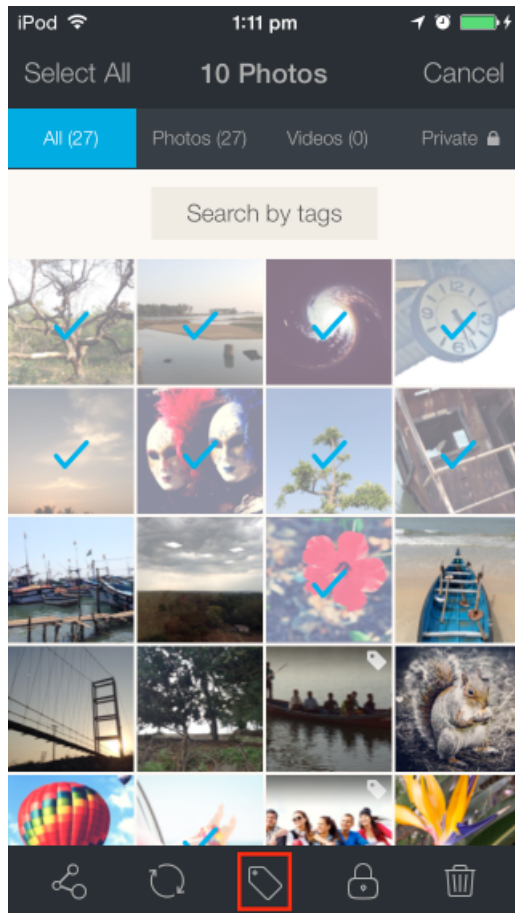
2. You can add new tags or edit existing ones.



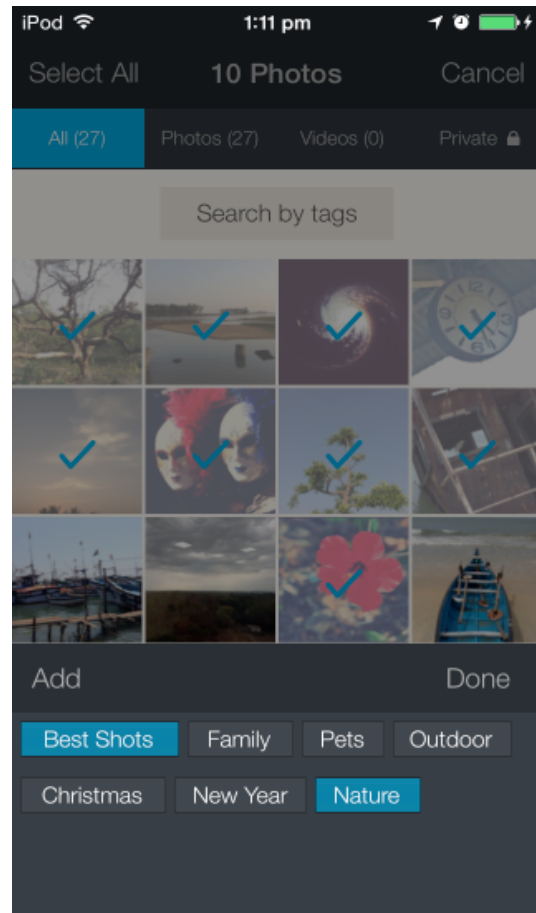
3. Add the name of a new tag.

Applying Tags:

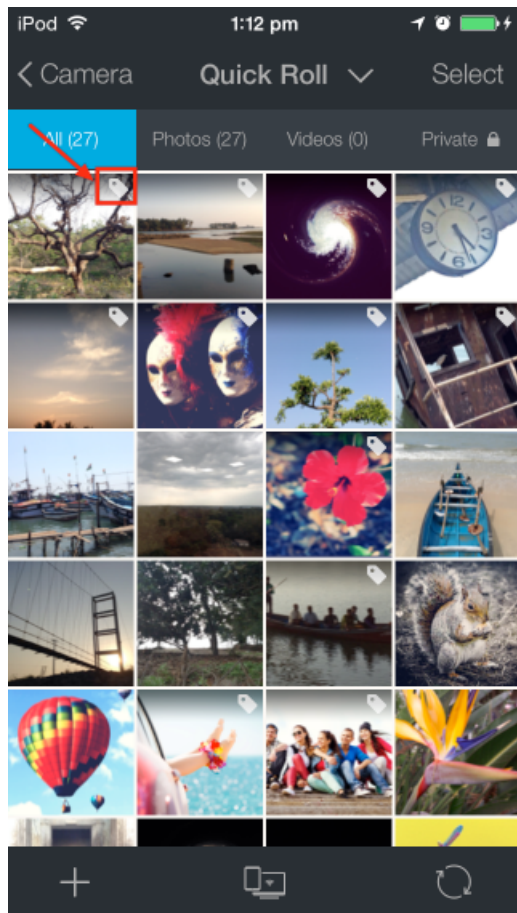
You can tag multiple photos and videos.



1. Select the photos and videos that you want to tag and hit the Tag icon.



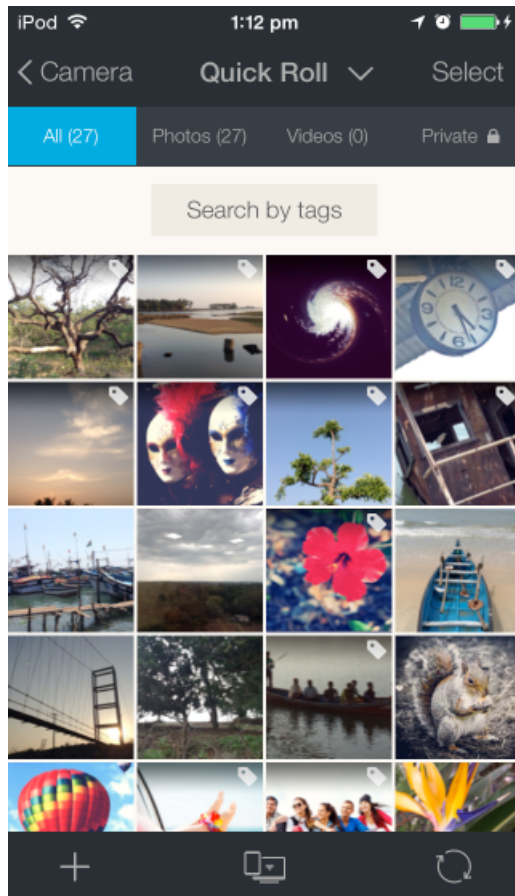
2. Apply tags that best define your captures or tap on Add' to add new tags.



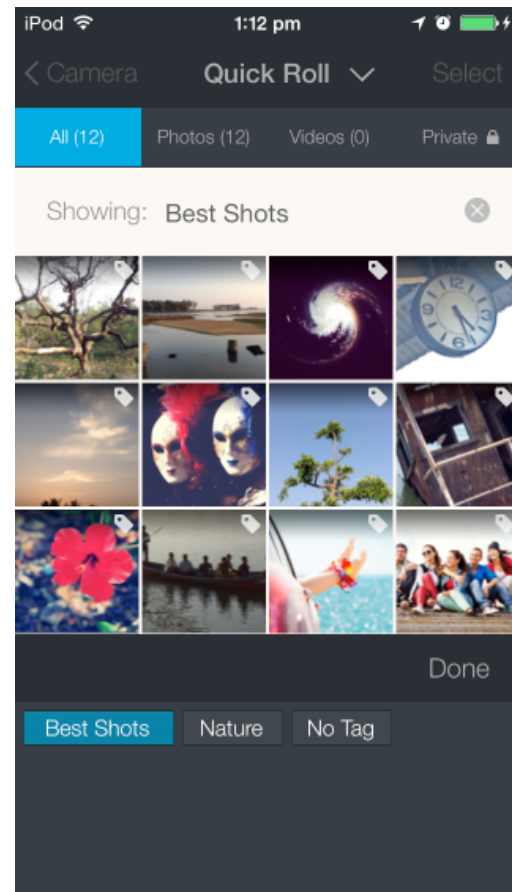
3. The tagged photos and videos will now sport the tag symbol as shown.

Tag Search:

You can search for photos and videos based on the Tags that have been used. To show the Tag search option, use your finger to perform a pull-down gesture in the Quick Roll.



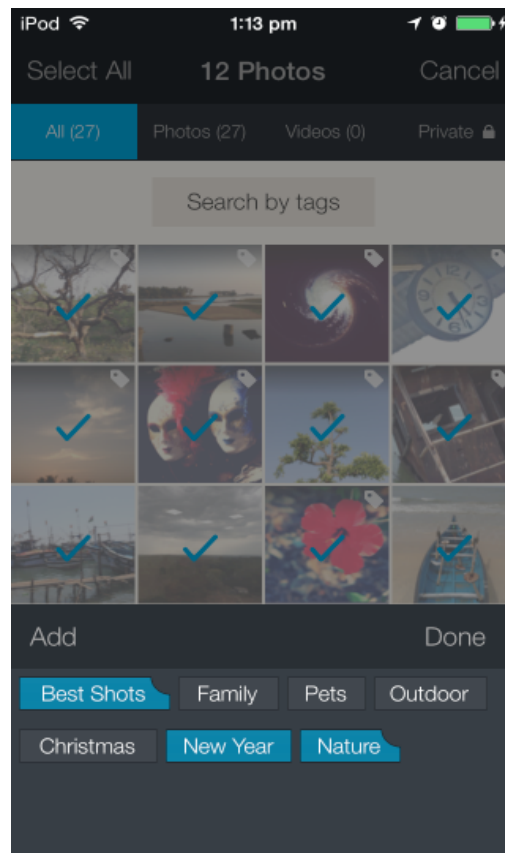
1. Drag down to bring up Tag Search. Tap on it to display the various tags used in photos and videos.



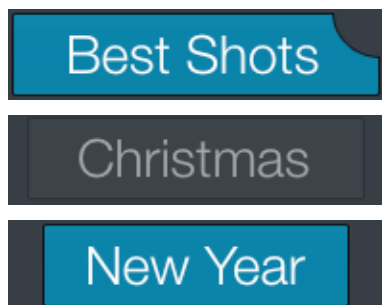
2. You can now search for photos and videos that are tagged under specific tags.

Editing your Tags from the Options Screen:

You can also edit/apply/remove Tags from the **Options** screen.



Select the tagged images and hit the tag icon to know more about the tags.

FAQ

For Videos:

Q What are the different resolutions I can record videos in?

You can choose to record from 2 settings:

For iPhone 5, 5c, 5s and iPod touch 5G:

Default - 1920x1080 resolution videos from the Rear camera and 1280x720 resolution using the Front camera.

FPS: ~30.

Custom – 640x480 from the Rear and Front cameras.

FPS: ~20

On iPhone 4s:

Default - 1920x1080 resolution from the Rear camera and 640x480 resolution using the Front camera.

FPS: ~30.

Custom – 640x480 from the Rear and Front cameras.

FPS: ~20

On iPhone 4:

Default – 1280x720 resolution from the Rear camera and 640x480 resolution using the Front camera.

FPS: ~30.

Custom – 640x480 from the Rear and Front cameras.

FPS: ~17

Q I want to include/exclude audio in videos.

By default, all videos are recorded with audio. However, you can choose not to include audio by disabling it in Settings>Videos.

Note: *Once turned OFF, videos recorded henceforth will be without any audio. You cannot regain their audio in the future.*

Q Can I pause when recording videos?

Yes, you can tap on the Pause icon present right next to the big red circular button. Press again to resume recording. This option, however, goes missing when you choose the 'Default' camera in Settings.

Q Can I zoom while recording videos?

Yes, you can zoom in real time when recording videos on supported devices. However this works only in the 'Custom' camera settings.

Q What are Time-Lapse videos?

With Time-Lapse videos, you get to create gorgeous fast-motion videos where there is a feeling that time is moving faster. You can change the desired interval in the Settings. Some interesting subjects that best demonstrate this feature are videos of plants growing, flowers blooming, people walking about, daily traffic and more. You can also apply Video Filters to make them more interesting. Do note that you cannot record Time-Lapse videos with the 'Default' camera settings; select 'Custom' instead.

Q Can I add filters to my videos?

Yes, absolutely! Camera Plus Pro comes with a host of brilliant Filters that you can apply before recording. You however cannot apply these filters when capturing using the 'Default' camera settings. Choose 'Custom' instead.

Q What format are videos recorded in?

All videos captured using Camera Plus Pro are in the '.mov' format, also the default format for iPhone videos. This format can be played back on most video players on your PC - QuickTime, iTunes, VLC, etc.

Q What more can I do with my videos?

You can edit your videos; apply Filters; apply Geo-tags; add tags; upload the videos via YouTube, Facebook, Instagram, Flickr, iMessage and Twitter; and mail them. Only YouTube accepts Geo-tags while uploading videos.

Q How can I delete my videos?

To delete a video, go to the Quick Roll. Long-press on the desired video, and an option to delete shall pop up. You can also select the video and then tap on the trashcan icon present below. Alternatively, you can also delete multiple videos at a time. Tap 'Select' and choose your desired files by clicking on them. Once selected, tap on the trashcan icon to delete them.

Q How do I change the resolution?

You can set the desired resolution in the Settings page, under Photos. You have 3 options to choose from: Original, Medium and Low.

Q Can I give a 'Flash' effect to my photos?

If a photo has turned out to be darker than anticipated and/or you're unhappy with just how low the lighting is, you can add a soft 'Flash' effect to enhance it. Simply tap on one of the three 'Flash' levels under Adjust > Flash to immediately make photos brighter.

Q How do I adjust/edit the appearance of my photos?

You have the option to adjust the Brightness, Saturation, Hue, Sharpness, Contrast, Tint and Temperature Control. You can also mix n' match these settings to get the desired output. You can also Crop, add Effects and Rotate photos.

Q Does the edited photo replace the original one?

No. After editing, the photo is saved as a separate file along with the tags and Geo-tag information.

Q Can I share multiple photos at once?

Yes. Tap on 'Select' in the Quick Roll and then choose all the desired photos by tapping on them. Now hit the Share button and choose the sites you want to share it to.

Q I want to publish a few photos to Flickr that are private.

You now have the option to choose whether or not you want photos to be accessible to the public, just before you publish them via Flickr.

Q Can I import photos from Camera Roll directly into the Private folder?

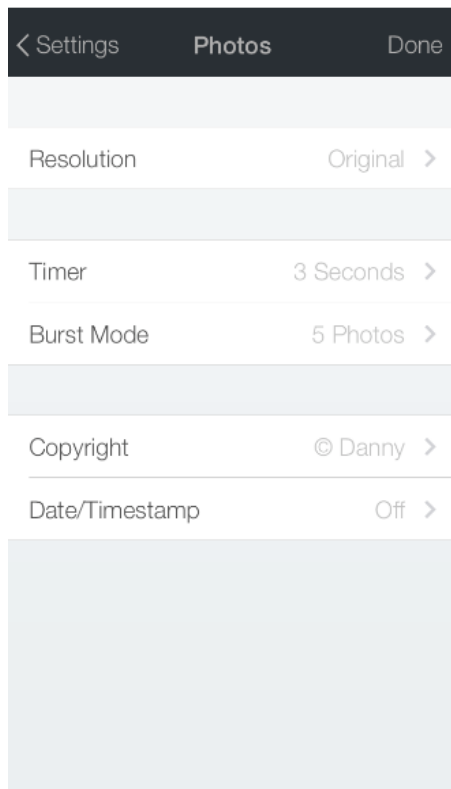
Yes. Open the Private folder and select the '+' icon on the bottom. You can now select photos from the Camera Roll. These photos, however, will be stored directly into the Private folder.

Q I want to imprint copyright and a Timestamp to my photos.

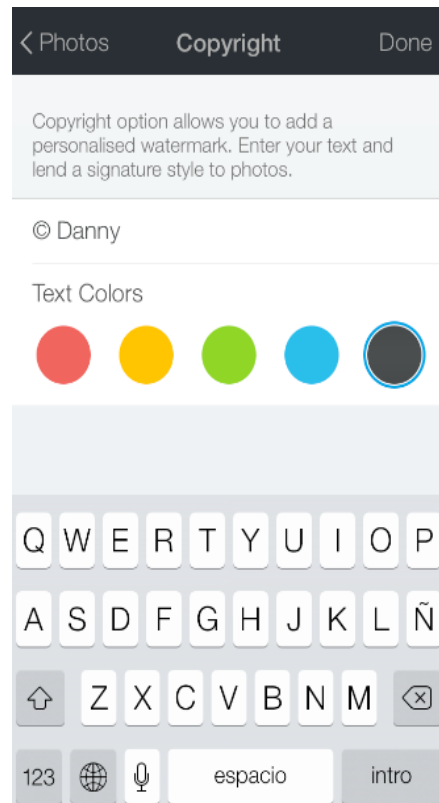
Yes. You enable the Copyright and Timestamp options under Settings>Photos.

Q Can I change the Copyright text and Timestamp colors?

Absolutely! You are provided with a set of colors to choose from under Settings>Photos.

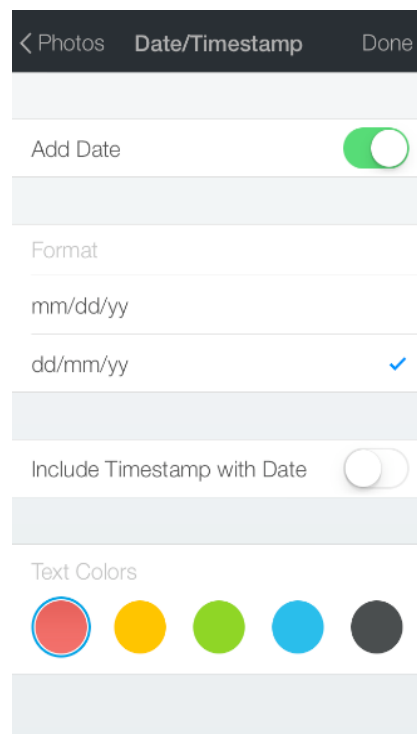


Go to 'Photos' under Settings

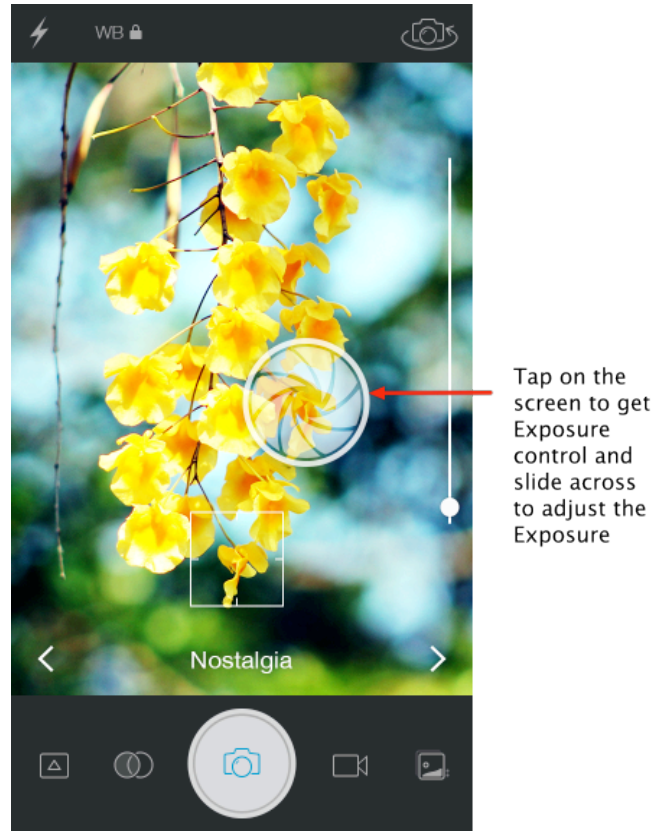

General:

Q How does Slide to Exposure work?

You can control Exposure by sliding your finger across the screen. Tap once to show the icon (Circular ring) and drag it towards the subject you wish to be exposed most. This is also available for videos.



Q What is Autofocus and how can it be locked?

Adjusting the focus is an essential part of photography. This highlights the desired subject more than the surrounding subjects. To Autofocus, simply tap once on the particular area and the focus is set automatically. However, this is reset whenever the camera is moved. In order to simplify things further, Camera Plus Pro also incorporates a Focus-Lock feature that locks the focus onto a particular area. Simply long-tap over the area to lock it.

Q What is White Balance Lock and how can I use it?

White Balance is important to maintain good shades of white in photographs (not bluish tints or hues of other colors as in several cases). With white balance in the automatic mode (AWB), the colors are recorded as they appear. If you do not want the camera to change the white balance under different lighting conditions you can tap on it once to lock it.

Q How do I know what options have been set while capturing a photo/video?

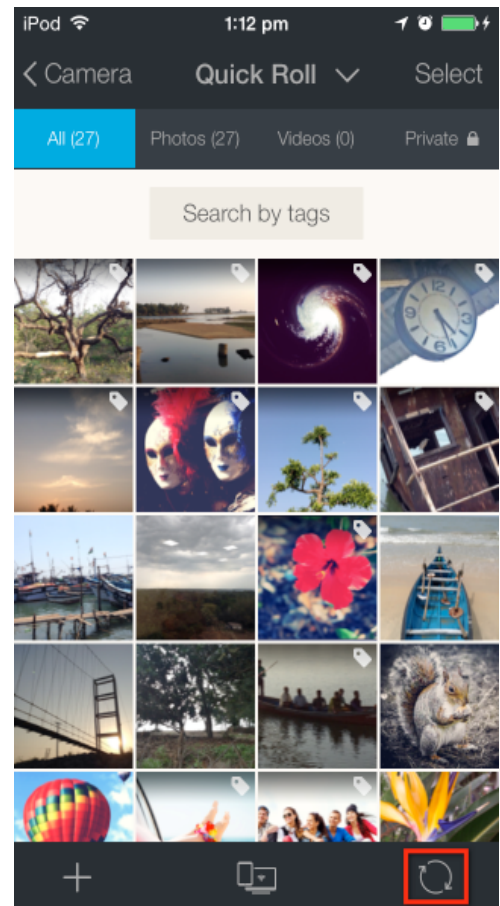
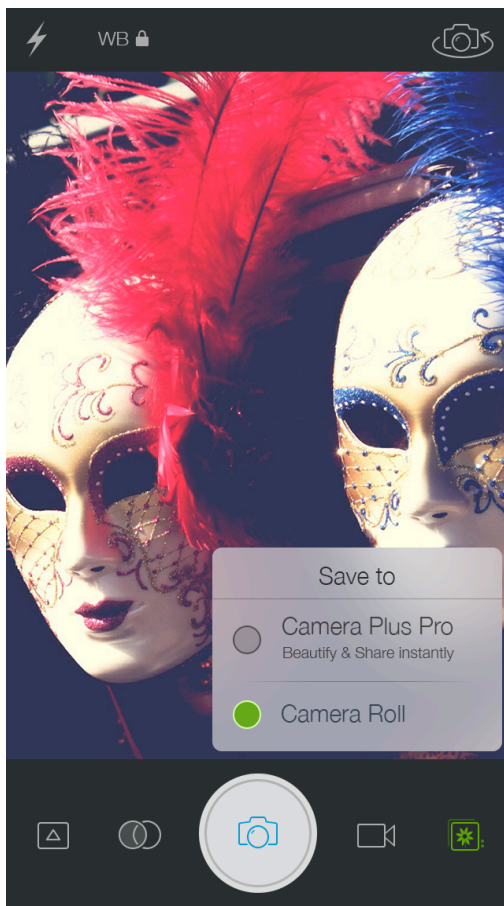
The photo capture or video recording screen changes according to the options selected. For photo captures, the Capture button will change for Anti-Shake, Timer and Burst Mode. For video recordings, the Record button will change if Time Lapse is switched on.

Q What is Quick Roll?

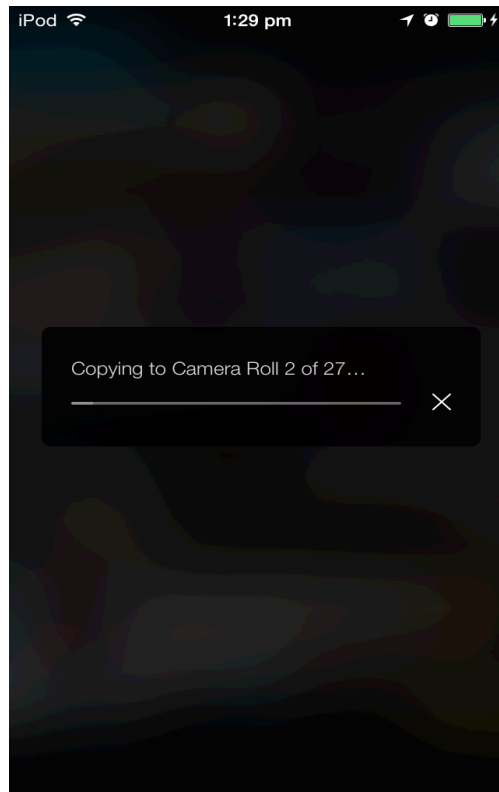
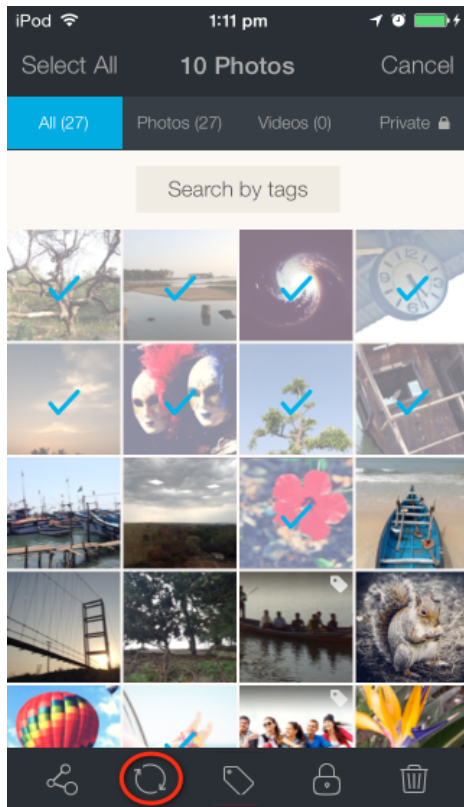
Quick Roll is your own personal library that contains all your photos and videos. Through the Quick Roll, you can share, edit or delete photos and videos. This is different from the default 'Camera Roll'. If you still prefer the default Camera Roll, you can enable 'Save to Camera Roll' under Settings.

Q Can I send my videos and photos to the Camera Roll?

Yes. You have two options here – you can either choose to sync all of your media to the Camera Roll or you can sync a desired number of photos/videos. If you'd like to sync all, tap on the sync icon given at the bottom. Else, tap on 'Select' and choose the files you want to sync. Now, tap on the sync icon below. The synced photos/videos will now be indicated with a small symbol on them. Refer to the following images:

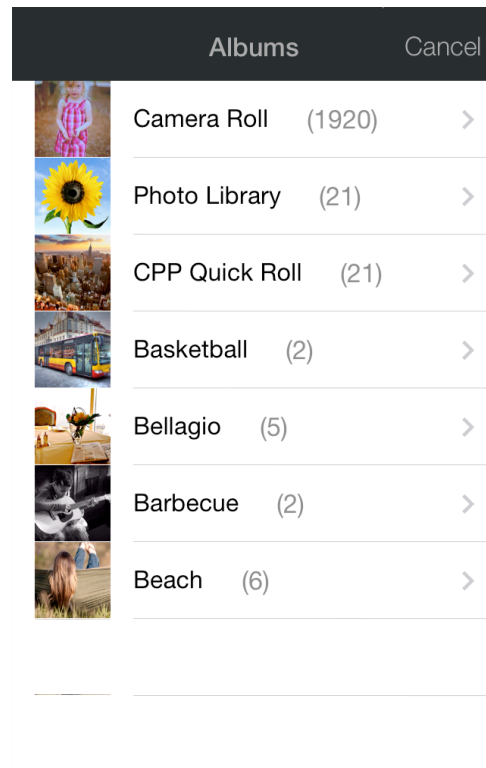
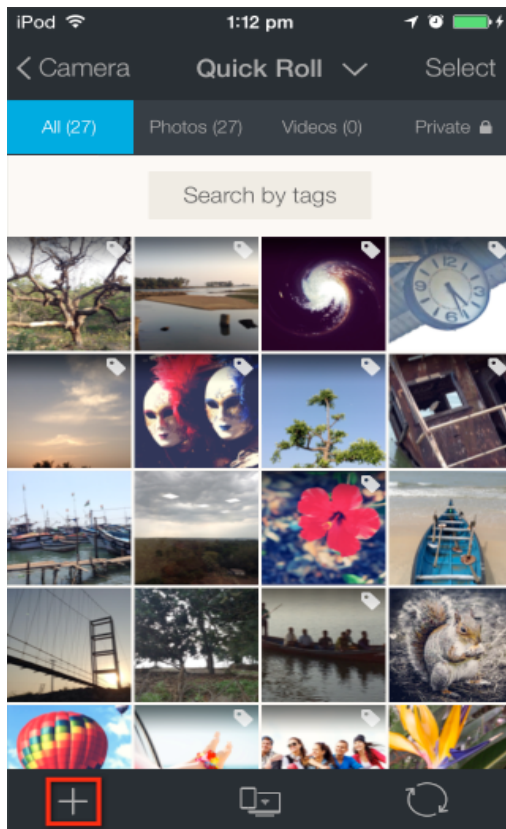

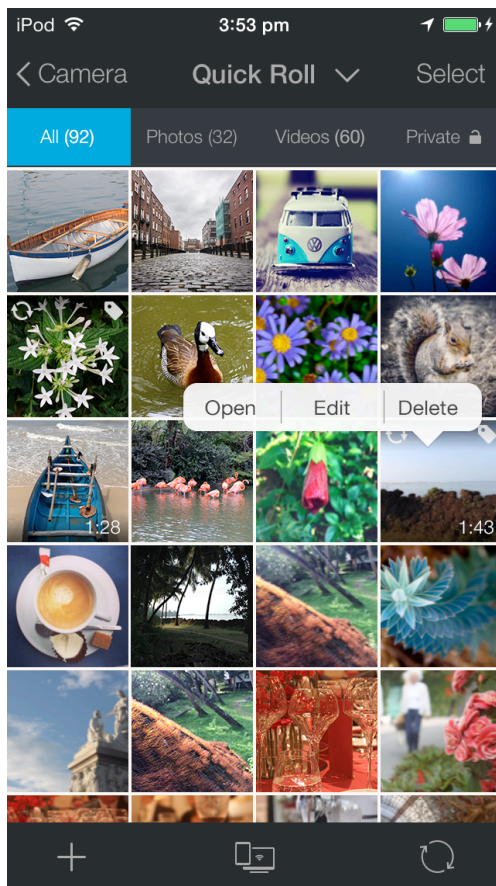

Q Can I edit photos present in other libraries including the Camera Roll?

Yes, you can. Click on the '+' symbol and choose any photo from the list of albums available in other libraries. Your photos are now imported and you can get to work on them using Camera Plus Pro.





Q Can I move photos/videos into the Private folder without setting the password?

Yes. However your captures can be viewed by anyone until locked. To hide the photos/videos, assign a password under Settings.

Q How is Quick Roll useful for me?

- Attach customized tags to photos and videos.
- Search for photos and videos using tags within your entire collection.
- Lock your private photos and videos by protecting them with a password.
- Share multiple photos simultaneously to Flickr, Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, etc.
- Upload photos and videos with tags to Flickr, YouTube and Facebook.

Q Can I add comments to my videos/photos before uploading?

Yes, a field to enter descriptive text and/or comments is present before you upload captures.

Q Can I share my photos/videos via FTP?

Yes, you can share your photos/videos via your favorite FTP client/browser.

Q Will my locked Photos/Videos appear during FTP transfers?

No, your locked Photos/Videos will not make any appearance. You have to unlock them for them to be seen.

Q Can I share my photos/videos via Wi-Fi?

Yes, you can share your photos/videos with your friends via Wi-Fi.

Q How do I login to the sites on the Share page?

In the Share screen, just tap on the icons corresponding to the site you want to upload your photos/videos to. If you're already logged in, the respective icon shall become highlighted. Else, you'll be prompted to login. You can also login in the Settings page.

Q What other languages is Camera Plus Pro available in?

Camera Plus Pro is available in French, German, Italian, Japanese and Spanish.
